## Virginia NeuroCare



Lakeview Virginia NeuroCare (LVN) in Charlottesville, provides a community integrated brain injury rehabilitation program, comprehensive evaluation, outpatient therapy clinic, vocational training and innovative community re-entry services for military and civilians with brain injury. LVN is a national leader in developing treatment modules for community reintegration and evolving use of technological aides. The experienced rehabilitation team and scientific agenda promote optimal treatment.

The LVN residential program is based in neighborhood apartments and at Grove House, a 24-hour supervised, family style home on the residential block of the LVN therapy center. LVN also operates a retail bookstore/gallery for vocational training, and a consumer-driven Clubhouse program, both located on the downtown pedestrian mall, a regional hub for recreation and the arts. LVN programs focus on skill acquisition as a foundation of independent living, community engagement and work re-entry. Treatment occurs in home, therapy center and 'real-world' environments to facilitate transfer of learning and optimize life potential.

## Shenandoah at Breezy Hill

Breezy Hill is a five acre estate nestled in the Shenandoah Valley in Weyers Cave, between Harrisonburg and Staunton, Virginia. The site provides 24 hour supervision, on-site nursing, neuropsychologist, clinical psychologist, occupational therapy, physical therapy and speech-language pathologist consultation from an integrated rehabilitation team, with on-going paraprofessional treatment extenders. Active rehabilitation and medical care are available through a variety of sources, and managed by the on-site program coordinator. The distinguished, historic home for seven participants, has been tastefully modernized with first floor full handicapped access. Amenities include multiple common areas, indoor pool, tennis courts, gardens, lawns, barbecue house and a workshop. Program participants are actively engaged in a broad variety of community integrated leisure, educational, volunteer and vocational options throughout the pastoral and historic Shenandoah Valley.

## Blue Ridge

This new community-integrated program provides intensive neurobehavioral treatment, comprehensive rehabilitation, a transitional unit, and supported living opportunities in a comfortable and cost-effective setting. Lakeview Blue Ridge is located in the heart of the vibrant Blacksburg and Virginia Tech community. The program sites include two home-like residences with therapy areas, which are fully accessible and have many amenities. All rooms are private with half baths en suite, and are wired for cable, phone and internet access. The program provides 24 hour awake supervision, on-site nursing, neuropsychology, behavior analyst and physician consultation, and a rehabilitation team (OT, PT, SLP, case management, recreation and clinical social work), with trained paraprofessional treatment extenders. Participants have access to a broad variety of community recreational, avocational and vocational options throughout the New River Valley region. Lakeview Blue Ridge emphasizes evidence-based treatment, a high quality of life, respect for individuality, and a focus on wellness.
